

Monthly Report on Economic and Trade Cooperation between Ningbo and Central and Eastern European Countries

(2023.4)

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Analysis of Ningbo's Imports from Central and Eastern European Countries

From January to April 2023, the trade volume between Ningbo and Central and Eastern European countries totaled 16.30 billion yuan, up 18.3% year on year, of which the import volume was 4.88 billion yuan, up 60.9% year on year. The growth rate was 59.2 and 0.3 percentage points higher than that of the country and the province respectively (1.7% of the country and 60.6% of the province), accounting for 7.2% and 71.5% of the country and the province respectively, an increase of 1.8 and 1.2 percentage points over the end of last year. Imports mainly present the following characteristics:

(1) From the perspective of the market, imports from Slovakia and Poland accounted for more than three-quarters. From January to April, the proportion of imports from Slovakia and Poland was 54.2% and 21.8% respectively, and the total proportion reached 76.0%. Among them, imports from Slovakia increased by 83.8% year on year, and the main commodities were automobiles; Imports from Poland increased 26.3% year on year, with copper being the main commodity. Driven by the import of refined oil products, imports from Greece increased 9.7 times year on year, ranking fourth in import scale. In addition, imports from

Croatia, Serbia, Slovenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, North Macedonia, Montenegro and other six countries accounted for less than 1%.

(2) From the perspective of commodity structure, resource related commodities account for more than 30%, with a significant driving effect. From January to April, the total imports of unforged rolled copper and copper, recycled copper raw materials, metal ore and mineral sands, steel and wood and their products totaled 1.71 billion yuan, with an increase of 39.9%, driving the import growth of 16.1 percentage points. **Cars are still the absolute main force driving imports.** From January to April, automobile imports reached 2.64 billion yuan, with an increase of 87.1% over the same period last year, accounting for more than 1/2, driving the import growth of 40.5 percentage points. **Agricultural imports were mixed.** From January to April, the import of agricultural products was 50.41 million yuan, down 18.3% year on year, mainly due to the import of dairy products and unlisted food decreased by 71.7% and 6% year on year respectively, reduce the import growth rate of agricultural products by 52.6 percentage points in total. The import of alcohol and beverages increased by 62.3% year on year, ranking first in the import scale. **Imports of consumer goods continued to decline.** From January to April, imports of consumer goods (except automobiles) totaled 96 million yuan, with a decrease of 34.3%, of which, imports of

dairy products, bags, toys and other categories declined, reducing 71.7%, 74.3% and 98% respectively, the total growth rate of consumer goods imports has been reduced by 34.6 percentage points..

(3) From the perspective of business entities, the entities of import enterprises continue to increase. From January to April, 12 of the top 30 enterprises in import ranking were newly listed enterprises, and 31 enterprises with imports exceeding 10 million yuan reached a total of 4.47 billion yuan, which achieved 91.6% of the city's imports volume, driving the city's import growth of 83.1 percentage points.

(4) From the regional point of view, Beilun District imports accounted for nearly 80% of the city, and many places achieved double growth. From January to April, Beilun District continued to rank as the largest import area, accounting for 78.2% of the city, with a year on year growth of 75.7%, and Yinzhou District and Zhenhai District were ranked second and third in terms of imports, with growth of 130.1% and 116% year on year respectively. In addition, Xiangshan County, Fenghua District have achieved double speed growth.
